The original silicone strap with a slide through clasp, daisygrip LITE provides:

- Easier access to patients with small anatomy
- Maximised comfort
- Reduced pinching risk
- Wiping disinfects clasps internal surface
- Magnet and metal free

When single use is required, daisygrip ONE provides:

- A patient specific tourniquet
- Ideal for high-risk patients or environments
- Up to 40x uses on a single patient
- Quick release fastening mechanism
- Single-handed operation

why daisygrip?



→ INFECTION CONTROL:

The daisygrip range **improves infection control practices**, with the ability to be completely disinfected and/or isolated to single patients.

Reusable tourniquets are tested for **10,000 applications*** or **2-years** and can be recycled, saving waste from landfill. Single patient use are tested for 40-uses.

→ ECONOMICAL:

Quality ensures a **smaller fleet of units** that last longer than conventional tourniquets.
